Sanitation of Sites:

- 1. Each Employee will be supplied with face masks, a bottle of hand sanitizer, and gloves. Employees are to avoid contacting "high-touch" areas as much as possible, such as handles, railings, posts etc. Hand sanitizer is to be used after coming into contact with "high-touch" areas. Masks are required to be worn if an employee has to come within 6 feet of another person while working on site.
- 2. Employees are to avoid sharing tools and equipment. If this is required, tools and equipment are required to be cleansed with the sanitizer provided.

Physical Distancing:

- 3. Each employee is expected to keep 6 feet away from others as much as possible while working on site. If it is necessary for an employee to come within 6 feet of another person, a mask is required to be worn during this time.
- 4. When taking breaks, it is required that employees will maintain social distancing and keep 6 feet apart at all times.

Work Scheduling:

- 5. Work will be planned to ensure each employee is working in their own space as much as possible throughout the workday.
- 6. Work will be planned to be ensure that minimal staff are assigned to each job to avoid overcrowding.

How Employees are to Report Illness:

- 7. The symptoms of COVID-19 are like many other illnesses, including the cold and flu. At this time, it is recommended that any worker who has any symptoms related to cold, flu or COVID-19 is to notify their superior immediately and be sent home. In addition, employees sent home should complete the online self-assessment or call either:
